1. What kind of school is Alma College?

- *Alma College is a four-year, undergraduate, private liberal arts and sciences institution. While you earn your bachelor's degree by studying your choice of more than 40 majors, minors, pre-professional programs, and self-designed Programs of Emphasis, you will also study courses outside your major that provide you with a well-rounded outlook on a variety of topics.*

2. Where is Alma located?

- *Alma College is located in Alma, MI, right in the center of the Lower Peninsula and about one hour north of Lansing.*

3. How many students are enrolled?

- *Alma's enrollment is approximately 1,400 students.*

4. What is the average class size?

- *Alma students enjoy an average class size of 18 students allowing for a very individualized classroom experience.*

5. What is the average GPA and ACT for incoming freshmen?

- *The average first-year student enters Alma with a 24 ACT and a 3.5 GPA.*

6. Do you have an application deadline/is there a fee?

- *Alma College offers rolling admission. Once your application is complete you will receive your admissions decision in approximately 2 weeks. Our application is free to submit through our website or through the Common Application.*

7. How do I schedule a visit to campus?

- *Students can schedule an individual visit or register for a weekend event day at www.alma.edu/visit.*

8. What types of scholarships do you offer?

- *Alma College has a variety of merit based and performance based scholarships available for students. A list can be found at www.alma.edu/scholarships. Please note, as a NCAA Division III institution, we do not award athletic scholarships.*
