## Alma College Immunization Requirements

- We require you to be up to date on ALL childhood immunizations, including tetanus.
  
- If you are **unable** to locate your immunization record, you can complete the immunization process in one of two ways:
  - 1) You may be revaccinated with two MMRs (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) given at least 1 month apart, and one dose of Td (Tetanus-Diphtheria) or Tdap (Tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis).
  
  - 2) You may get a blood test to show your immunity to MMR. You also will need a Td or Tdap within the last 10 years.

### **Required for all international students only:**

#### Tuberculosis Skin Test

(This test must be done with the past year and in the USA. A chest x-ray is required if the skin test is positive. Please fax x-ray report to Wilcox Medical Center 989-463-7351)

Please note: The CDC (Center for Disease Control) and ACHA (American College Health Association) **highly recommend** additional vaccines for college students, including:

- **Varicella vaccine (chicken pox)** if you have not had the chicken pox
  
- **Meningitis vaccine**
  
- **Hepatitis A and B vaccines**
