November

- ◆ Receive your Award Letter! (perspective Freshmen)

March

- ◆ 1st State of Michigan Grant
Be sure you have filed your FAFSA and put our school as #1 choice. This qualifies you to become eligible for the State of Michigan Grant!
(pending Financial Need)

- ◆ Becoming A Scot Day!
Be sure you are checking in with your Admissions Rep. to see when and if you can schedule for BASD!

June

- ◆ Becoming a Scot Day!
Are you signed up? If not reach out to your admissions rep! There will be a few days offered in June and July!
- ◆ How Will You Pay For College?
Now is the time to figure out how you will pay off your Fall Term that is due at the end of August! Good time to get your finances all figured out!

July

- ◆ Federal Direct Loans!
If you are borrowing your loans, be sure to accept, complete Entrance Counseling and MPN. Completing this by July will insure that they will be applied to the bill.
- ◆ Enroll in CashNet
If you are interested in setting up a payment plan, note that this starts in August.
