



ALMA COLLEGE ATHLETICS SPECTATOR PLAN

INDOOR SPECTATORS

Alma College will allow each participating coach and student-athlete two parent/guardians to attend home contests in Art Smith Arena. These spots are non-transferable. We will also allow Alma College community members to be spectators. A maximum of 100 spectators, 60 for parents and 30 for campus community members will be allowed in the arena. Alma College spirit groups such as the spirit squad and dance team will be allowed in the arena and to perform at half-time when the teams are no longer on the court.

Family Spectator Protocols and Restrictions:

- Prior to arriving on campus, outside spectators will have to preregister, provide contact information, and complete an online health screening:

 - Registration and the pre-event health screening form must be completed 3 days prior to the event via email/online.
 - If the registration and health form is not completed within 24 hours, they will be given a final reminder by phone. If the forms are still not complete, no access will be granted.
- When spectators arrive on campus, they will check-in with staff members, have their temperature taken, and complete a day of screening before that are admitted in to the building.
- Family members will enter Art Smith Arena on the southwest side of the building and be seated on the south west side of the arena.
- The southwest side of the area will have spaced out and labeled seats, and no one will be seated in the first three rows.
- Due to the Hogan Lobby being stanchioned and restricted to game personnel, there will be a porta potty available for visitors.
- All spectators will be required to wear a face covering at all times and no food or beverages will be allowed into the arena.
- Spectators will be not be allowed to interact with players under any circumstances.

Campus Community Spectators:

- There will be 30 spots available for Alma College campus community members (students, faculty, staff).
- Campus community members will sign-up using the sign-up genius linked in the campus calendar, once all spots are filled registration will close.

- Campus community members will enter on the southeast side of the building and show their green check mark from their daily health screening.
- The southeast side of the arena will have spaced out and labeled seats, and no one will be seated in the first three rows.
- Due to the Hogan Lobby being stanchioned and restricted to game personnel, there will be a porta potty available for visitors.

- All spectators will be required to wear a face covering at all times and no food or beverages will be allowed into the arena.
- Spectators will not be allowed to interact with players under any circumstances.

JV/Varsity and Spirit Group Seating:

- Spirit groups will have to show their daily health screening, and enter at the south west side of the building. They will be seated in the center and southside of the bowl section of the bleachers.
- When JV/Varsity players of the opposing team are not playing they will be seated on the north side of the bowl, near their teams' bench.
- When JV/Varsity players from the home team are not playing they will be seated on or behind the team bench.
- JV/Varsity players will enter the arena through the designated entrances in the Hogan Lobby.

STUNT and Dance Competition Spectators:

- Due to the size of the STUNT roster, STUNT spectators will be restricted to two parents/guardians for participating coaches and student-athletes.
- Spirit groups will not be in attendance for home STUNT contests.
- All other protocols and restrictions will apply.
- All protocols will remain the same for the single combined cheer and dance competition with the exception utilizing the bowl for additional seating.

Operations and Set Up

Sign-Up and Check-In Process:

Parents:

- Coaches will be responsible for sharing the Qualtrics survey with their student-athletes and parents.
- Hogan front desk workers will monitor the registration/ health screening survey and make sure all guests have completed the health screening a within 24 hours of the event. If the pre-health screening has not been completed within that time frame, access to the building will not be granted.
- All parents will check-in for the event on the south west side of the Hogan building. Two student-workers will help spectators complete a day of screening form and check temperatures.

Campus Community:

- Campus community members will be sign-up using a sign-up genius link within the campus calendar. The link will go live three days before the contest and registration will close once all spots have been filled.
- Hogan front desk workers will monitor the registration process and individuals that did not sign-up with not be granted access to the building.
- All campus community members will check-in for the event on the south west side of the Hogan building. Campus community members will be required to show their daily screening check mark.

Spirit Squad and Dance:

- Coaches will be responsible for all check-in and seating for their teams.

Set Up:

Bleachers:

- As noted in the seating chart photos, two 30-yard ropes dividing sections will need to be set up to divide the visiting team and spirit groups and to divide parents and campus community members.
- 30 Individual seats will need to be marked off for the campus community members.
- 30 pairs will need to be marked off for parent spectators.

Entrance/Exit:

- Porta potties will need to be placed on the south west side of the Hogan building for all spectators.
- A table and stanchions will need to be set up for the check-in process.
- Signage that indicates which door is an exit and entrance.
- Two hand sanitizer stations at the by the entrance and exit doors.

OUTDOOR SPECTATORS

Alma College will allow each participating coach and student-athlete 4 family members from the same household to attend home contests on Bahlke, and 2 family members from the same household at the remaining outdoor facilities. These spots are non-transferable. We will also allow Alma College community members to be spectators. Alma College spirit groups such as the spirit squad and band will be allowed in the competitive venue and to perform at half-time when the teams are no longer on the field. We will continue to reevaluate this as the season progresses.

Family Spectator Protocols and Restrictions:

- Prior to arriving on campus, outside spectators will have to preregister, provide contact information, and complete an online health screening:

- Spectators will be not be allowed to interact with players under any circumstances.

Spectators limits by venue:

Bahlke – 250

Tennis Courts – 80

Klenk Park – 100

Scots' Park – 100

SPORT SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

Football:

- 2 guests for home team members only for football (max 164) – Sitting in home team section and using home team restrooms
- Band seating in South Bahlke Endzone (Band = 80)
- Spirit Squad section in North Bahlke endzone (Spirit Squad = 22)
- Alma Campus Community Spectators (possibly in visitors' section) = (80 max)
- Restrooms under the press box will be reserved for outside guest – all student-athletes and Alma Community members will need to use the Hogan or the Rec Center. Guests of Alma College will also not be permitted to use any other restrooms or enter any indoor spaces.
- Parents/guardians and campus community spectators will have different entrances into the stadium.

Other outdoor sports:

Men's Lacrosse (Bahlke)

- max 180 family members (sitting in home section)
- 75 Alma College Community (sitting in the visitors' section)

Women's Lacrosse (Bahlke)

- Max 160 family members (sitting in home section)
- 75 Alma College Community (sitting in the visitors' section)

M/W Soccer (Bahlke)

- Max 140 family members (sitting in home section)
- 75 Alma College Community (sitting in visitors' section)

Softball (Scots' Park)

- Max 60 parents/guardians
- 30 Alma College Community
- Reserve one section of bleachers for students
- We would section off the bleachers for families/solo guests. Capacity in stands to be determined – most seating will be standing room around the fence line. No close contact to either dugout – we would need to rope this off and make signage for bullpens to remain 6 feet or further away
- All visitors will have to check-in at their designated check-in location; once checked in they will receive a wristband that must be worn while at the venue.

Baseball (Klenk Park)

- Max 72 parents/guardians
- 30 Alma College Community
- Reserve one section of bleachers for students

- We would section off the bleachers for families/solo guests. Capacity in stands to be determined – most seating will be standing room around the fence line. No close contact to either dugout – we would need to rope this off and make signage for bullpens to remain 6 feet or further away
- All visitors will have to check-in at their designated check-in location; once checked in they will receive a wristband that must be worn while at the venue.

Tennis (Tennis Courts)

- Men – 20 parent/guardians
- Women – 28 parent/guardians
- Max at venue 80 – Alma College Community dependent on which gender is playing
- Signage to stay distanced from student-athlete
- No spectators allowed if moved indoors
- All visitors will have to check-in at their designated check-in location; once checked in they will receive a wristband that must be worn while at the venue.

Golf (Pohl Cat)

- Guests allowed at the discretion of Pohl Cat

Protocols for all above:

- 2-4 guests for home team members only; depends on sport specific guidelines.
- Order 2 porta potties for tennis
- Order one porta pottie for each dug out at softball and baseball
- Order 2 additional porta potties for softball
- Guests of Alma College will also not be permitted to use any other restrooms or enter any indoor spaces, unless stated in future literature
- Registration link online with health screening for outside fans and temp checks
- Green checks and temp checks for students/staff
- Different entrances for students/staff and guests

Outdoor – Tennis

- 2 guests for home team members only
- Reserve visiting team bleachers for Alma College Community
- Order 2 porta potties - Guests of Alma College will also not be permitted to use any other restrooms or enter any indoor spaces.
- Registration link online with health screening for outside fans and temp checks
- Green checks and temp checks for students/staff
- Different entrances for students/staff and guests
- All visitors will have to check-in at their designated check-in location; once checked in they will receive a wristband that must be worn while at the venue.

Track and Field:

- 2 guests for home team members only for football (max 120) – Sitting in home team section and using home team restrooms
- Alma Campus Community Spectators (possibly in visitors' section) = (80 max)
- Restrooms under the press box will be reserved for outside guest – all student-athletes and Alma Community members will need to use the Hogan or the Rec Center. Guests of Alma College will also not be permitted to use any other restrooms or enter any indoor spaces.
- Parents/guardians and campus community spectators will have different entrances into the stadium.
- All visitors will have to check-in at their designated check-in location; once checked in they will receive a wristband that must be worn while at the venue.
