

Model UN Day Workshop 2021

COVID Response Plan

This plan outlines the process in which Admissions will conduct the Model UN Day Workshop event on campus Thursday, April 15th.

Please note: April 15th is Honor's Day. With Honor's Day taking place virtually this year, we have been able to secure spaces in Dow that will not be in use during this event as no classes will be in session.

Pre-Event

- Health screenings will be sent before the event.
- The total number of guests allowed to visit is limited to 15 students + one guest (max of 30 guests).

During Event

- Health screenings will be given day of event and temperature checked before interacting with our campus staff/faculty/students.
- Social distancing and mask protocols are in place.
- Scheduling ensures that only Admissions staff/student staff and members of the Model UN program (current students and Dr. Hulme) will interact with guests.
- The size of guest groups will remain small and manageable for COVID-19 guidelines.
- Limited spaces on campus have been reserved to ensure guests do not come in direct contact with several different spaces.
- No shared food experiences will occur.
- The spaces we will be utilizing will be properly secured and not accessible for anyone but those working the event and guests (stanchions will be put up, proper signage will be placed around, a member working the event will be there to ensure only the correct people enter the space).
- Breakout sessions will be small groups of a 1:2 ratio of Model UN program member/guests.

After Event

- Cleaning work orders will be in place to ensure all spaces will be disinfected after the event has concluded.
