

Tax Information Sheet:

2023-24 Verification Requirement

Per federal regulations tax documents are required for <u>both tax filers</u> and <u>non-tax filers</u>, view below to see what documents you and your parents are required to provide. <u>Please note that tax filers have 3 options available.</u>

Tax Filers: Option A

Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) within FAFSA

Log into your FAFSA to link both the parent and student IRS income tax information:

1. Navigate to the "parent financials" section (and then the "student financials" after)



2. Click on "link to IRS"; follow the prompts to link the taxes back to the FAFSA



3. Once both parent and student income is linked, make sure to save, sign, and submit!

Tax Filers: Option B

2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript

There are <u>3 options</u> to obtain the 2021 tax return transcript from the IRS.

- 1. Online: https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript
 - a. Receive online or by mail the 2021 Tax Return Transcript
- 2. **Phone**: 1-800-908-9946
 - a. Request via phone for the 2021 Tax Return Transcript (to be mailed)
- 3. File Form 4506-T
 - a. Form is available at https://www.irs.gov/

- Check **box** #7: Verification of Non-filing!
- Be sure to fill out entire form and Mail or Fax. (Instructions on Form)

*NOTE: This requirement is for <u>independent students</u> and <u>parents of dependent students</u>

Unusual Filing Circumstances

Please contact our office to find out what is needed if you have an unusual filing circumstance, such as:

- Filed an amended IRS income tax return
- Granted filing extension by the IRS
- Victim of IRS identity theft
- Filed a non-IRS income tax return

IMPORTANT DOCUMENT NOTE: If you are applying for aid at other schools, please make a copy of your tax transcript for your records before you submit it to a school.
