Per federal regulations tax documents are required for **both tax filers and non-tax filers**, view below to see what documents you and your parents are required to provide. **Please note that tax filers have 3 options available.**

Tax Filers: Option A

2024 IRS Tax Return Transcript

There are 3 options to obtain the 2024 tax return transcript from the IRS.

1. **Online:** <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>
 - a. Receive online or by mail the 2024 Tax Return Transcript
2. **Phone:** 1-800-908-9946
 - a. Request via phone for the 2024 Tax Return Transcript (to be mailed)
3. **File Form 4506-T**

Copy of 2024 1040 Form (with Schedules 1, 2, & 3)

- Be sure to fill out entire form and Mail or Fax. (Instructions on Form)
