## Academic Catalog – Errors, Omissions and Revisions (Print Version)

### Business (BUS)

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*Change:* The Business Minor should provide an option for students to take BUS-221 OR BUS-333. Course organization was the error, not the specific courses listed.

The accurate minor requirements are:

#### **Business Administration Minor Requirements**

Eighteen credits, which must include:

1. ACC-221 or BUS-333;
2. BUS-117 and BUS-121;
3. Nine additional credits of BUS at the 200-level or above.

### Dance (DAN)

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*Change 1:* An incorrect reduction in the Physical Practice requirement. Requirement should remain as 8-credit required, not as 4-credits printed in the catalog.

*Change 2:* Total credits listed in the major should be thirty-three, not twenty-nine.

The accurate major requirements are as listed:

#### **Dance Major Requirements**

##### **Thirty-three credits, which must include:**

1. **Eight credits of Physical Practice**, from the following categories\*:
  - a) Minimum one credit from DAN-244 Intermediate Ballet or DAN-344 Advanced Ballet;
  - b) Minimum one credit from DAN-240 Intermediate Modern or DAN-340 Advanced Modern;
  - c) Complete DAN-160 and 245, or other approved physical practice course approved by DAN dept.
2. Four credits of Performance: DAN-151 or other approved theater performances, or independent projects.
3. Nine credits of Foundations of Dance Research: DAN-146, 201, and 351.

4. Ten credits of Applications of Dance Research: DAN-220, 302, 384, and 385.
5. Two credits of Dance Research Synthesis: DAN-495 or 500

### English, Communication, and Language (ECL)

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*Change:* The context elective course set within the Communication and English Majors should list ECL-124 Developing Leaders (3 credits) as an option for the majors.

The accurate major requirements are:

#### **Communication Major Requirements**

30 Credits, which must include:

1. Core: 12 credits: ECL-120, 220, 320, & 420.
2. Context: 6 credits to be selected from the following courses. At least one course must be upper-level (200+)
  - ECL-113, 121, 122, 123, 124, 131, 132, 133, 190, 201, 202, 203, 214, 215, 290-295, 303
3. Electives: 9 credits to be selected from your chosen Major. At least one course must be 300+ level.
  - ECL-221, 227, 231, 240, 242, 250, 252, 254, 270, 271, 327, 340, 350, 371
4. Practicum or Internship: 3 credits in ECL 385 *or an applied learning experience* approved by the department.

#### **English Major Requirements**

30 Credits, which must include:

1. Core: 12 credits: ECL-120, 220, 320, & 420.
2. Context: 6 credits to be selected from the following courses. At least one course must be upper-level (200+)
  - ECL-113, 121, 122, 123, 124, 131, 132, 133, 190, 201, 202, 203, 214, 215, 290-295, 303
3. Electives: 9 credits to be selected from your chosen Major. At least one course must be 300+ level.
  - ECL-227, 231, 241, 242, 251, 253, 261, 327, 341, 343, 351, 353
4. Practicum or Internship: 3 credits in ECL 385 *or an applied learning experience* approved by the department.

## Kinesiology & Health Sciences (KHS)

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*Change:* Late in the WI26 term, the KHS department created a new course KHS-141 Introduction to Kinesiology (3 credits). The course form detailed a request for KHS-141 to replace KHS-131 Foundations of Physiology within the KHS core.

The accurate major requirements are as listed:

### **Kinesiology & Health Sciences Major Requirements**

Thirty-six credits, minimum, which must include:

1. Core (18 credits): **KHS-141**, 231, 232, 301 and 327
2. Select one concentration:
  - Clinical Exercise Physiology (20 cr):
    - o KHS-233, 328, 402, 418, 419, 420; and 2 elective credits which must be 300-level or higher (not including KHS-385, 480, or 500).
  - Pre-Therapy (18 cr):
    - o KHS-310 or 311; 345 and 444; 401 or 403; and 6 credits from the following: 233, 234, 235, 328, 335. The cognate for this concentration is PHY-112 or 121.
  - Pre-Medicine (18 cr):
    - o KHS-310 or 311; 401 or 402 or 403 or 404; 444; 264 or 331 or 430; and 6 additional credits from the previous options or the following: 170, 265, 328, 341, 418, 419, 420.
  - Public Health (15 cr):
    - o KHS-264, 330, 331, 430; and 3 credits from the following: 170, 265, KHS-310 or 311, and 328.
3. Completion of the HAPS Comprehensive Examination (national, standardized examination) administered by the Department.
4. Completion of 3 credits of KHS Practicum (KHS-385), Senior Seminar (KHS-480), or Senior Thesis (KHS-500).

Note: For some concentrations, First Aid and CPR certification are required by external internship/practicum programs.
